For our overseas outreach, we invite children in our parish to write to children in an **orphanage in Ukraine**. A **box for cards** is by the altar. Donations will provide the children with a Christmas lunch. Local support will go to **Life**. Life is a UK charity for women facing unexpected pregnancy. Life has two houses locally for young women and their babies who would otherwise be homeless. A **Giving Tree for Life** has been set up in the porch. The tree has tags with gifts needed. **Please take a tag if you can, purchase the gift** on it, and place the gift **under the tree or on the altar** as soon as possible so we can get them to where they are needed!

CAFOD is making its annual Advent appeal, also focussing on families in Ukraine, through its **World Gifts** that benefit those who need our help the most. These can be ordered online now, or through a paper catalogue (copies in the porch), or by phoning CAFOD.

The **Parish Pastoral Council** is planning for the new year when we celebrate the **Jubilee Year**, **Pilgrims of Hope**. In addition to focussing on the regular Church seasons (Lent, Easter, Pentecost, Season of Creation, Advent, etc), our focus this year will be on how we can live as pilgrims, as people of faith and hope. Some **events/activities planned** are: a three-week course in the context of the Jubilee year starting in January, a Divine Mercy retreat (in Lent), pilgrimages to Walsingham and Arundel, a one-day retreat leading on from our recent weekend retreat and, hopefully, a walk along part of the Pilgrim's Way. We'll also be participating as a parish in Diocesan-wide events, including the **Festival of Hope** on **20 September**. Details to follow in due course.

Plans are also moving forward as the Steering Group for the new **Weybridge Parish** (currently all parishes in the Weybridge Deanery) continues to meet monthly, to discern how to implement Bishop Richard's Pastoral Plan for our Diocese. The group is discerning, along with all clergy in our deanery, on the Vision for the new parish, which we shall be sharing with parishioners in the new year.
