WORK IN THE CHURCH

We are progressing well with phase one of the sanctuary renovation, which is to clean, skim and paint the walls and ceiling. Phase 2 will be redecorating the back of the sanctuary and to see how we can upgrade it. The final phase will be to replace the carpet - we might have carpet and oak flooring. We are progressing rapidly thanks to the large team working with us. They are working long hours - most days they have worked from 8am to 10pm to do as much work as possible. This is the biggest improvement since the late early 90s.

This is our church - we are investing in it to give it a new lease of life and enhance our worship.

There will be no weekday Masses next week (10th, 11th and 12th), apart from Friday, to maximise the work. The following week we will only have Mass on Wednesday (19th) (Feast of St Joseph) and Friday (21st).
