A little note of caution: you'll note that we are still not seeing any growth in regular giving, meaning that we are operating at a deficit of around £300 per week. Perhaps you could take a moment at the start of this new year and reflect: If we could all manage just £1 per person per month more on average, that would make a huge difference to our parish finances and to what we can achieve together in the future.
